Developments

- A paper to be submitted to Health Policy

Major health reforms in 31 high-income countries in 2018 and 2019: a comprehensive overview of the top 3 national reforms in both years

- All HSPM contributors invited to be co-authors.
- Comment period closes Nov 6th.
- Incorporate experiences into new Observatory/HSPM website
 - More systematic monitoring of reforms
 - Better visualization of reform trends across countries



The 2020 survey

- Aims:
 - Overview of 2020 reforms (impact of COVID?)
 - Implementation status of 2018 and 2019 reforms
- Survey sent out on Oct 7th
 - All countries responded, last answer: yesterday, 18:00
- New in 2020 survey: Reform definition:
 - “A purposeful process that involves systematic policy, structural and/or process changes and is aimed at achieving desired goals”
