

Profile: Dr. Vittal Mogasale, MBBS, MPH, PhD

Dr. Vittal Mogasale, M.B.B.S., M.P.H., Ph.D., is Research Scientist at Policy and Economic Research Center, International Vaccine institute, Seoul, South Korea. He leads a team of researchers conducting policy and economic studies to develop evidence for introducing new and improved vaccines for cholera, typhoid and dengue in developing countries. His current work involves development of global vaccine Investment cases, vaccine demand and supply forecast, cost-effectiveness analyses, cost of illness studies, private willingness to pay for vaccines and estimation of vaccination costing.

In the past, Vittal has worked for the control of sexually transmitted infections and for polio eradication over a decade with various organizations in India including Family Health International and World Health Organization. He has obtained his Medical Degree (1997) from Manipal University, India; International Masters in Public Health from Hebrew University, Israel (2003) and Doctor of Philosophy from University of Queensland, Australia (2011).
